Research shows that students who are involved with a TRiO program have higher GPA's, earn more credits, and are twice as likely to stay in college than students who do not receive that support.

Who qualifies? First you must be a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident and enrolled in a degree-seeking program at the Pendleton campus of Blue Mountain Community College. In addition, you must meet at least one of the following criteria: Meet federal income guidelines; Be first generation (neither parent or guardian graduated with a Bachelor's degree); Have a documented learning or physical disability.
